onomics teacher in Nash County has a Master's Degree while every Negro home economics teacher in the county has hers? (True)

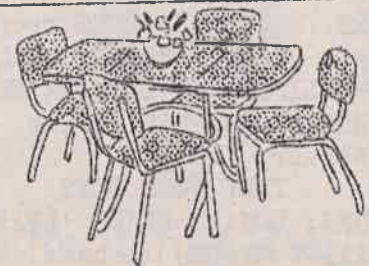

Inside Junior Bass's locker. (Looks as if everyone in high school has donated him a pencil.)

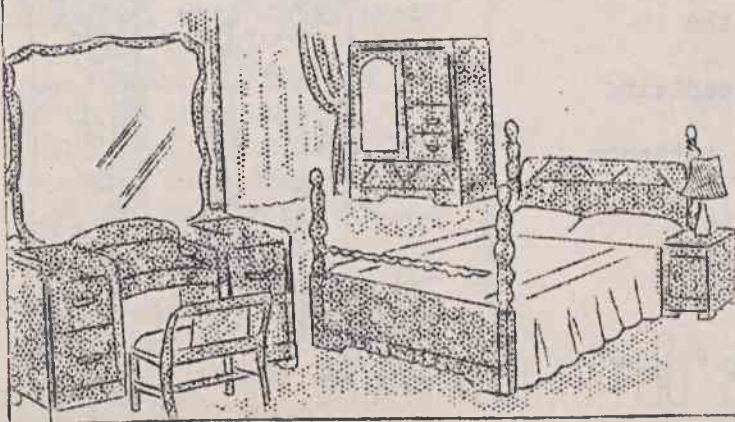
