
Test Results To Aid Future Education

To help teachers better determine the educational needs of the ninth grade boys and girls, in the academic and non-academic areas, C. H. Fries, assistant county superintendent, gave to this group an aptitude test the last of January.

This test, American Council On Education Psychological Examination, was not given to see how much each student knew but to determine his educational needs, says Fries. Cnly a few questions on the test were supposed to be answered by a ninth grade student, he added.
