On October 9 the District Four Rally will convene in Franklinton. This district is composed of 12 counties.

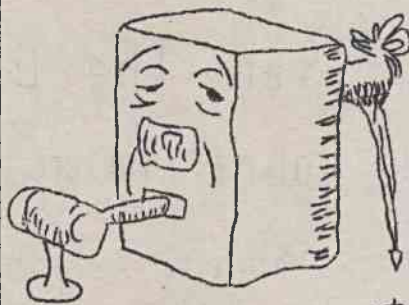
Prior to the opening of school, Jane Burgess and Louise Wells attended a meeting for the District Rally.

Bailey expects to have a large number present.

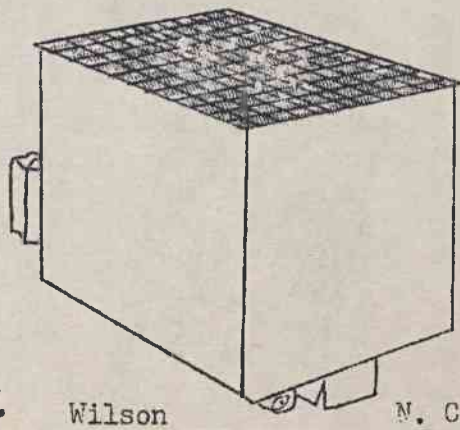
