Because there have been several "minor" accidents in the past few weeks caused by one school bus following too closely to another, the North Carolina Department of Motor Vehicles passed a ruling on February 2 affecting all North Carolina school bus drivers.

The ruling states: "Any school bus driver following nearer than 300 feet to another school bus is to be charged with careless and reckless driving." Any school bus Driver caught violating this rule will have his school bus license revoked, is also emphasized.

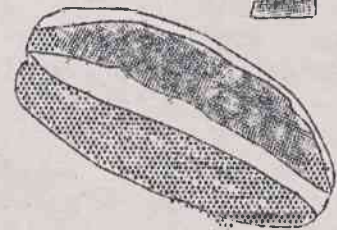
