

Better Teaching' Aim Of Year Asserts Weaver

"To improve instruction", immediately answered Principal M. W. Weaver when called upon at this PTA to give the main objective of the school year.

Pointing out that Nash County rates lower than the national average in scholastic achievement and that tests given in the ninth and twelfth years at Bailey reveal that Bailey students are not as well prepared as seniors as they are as freshmen, Weaver declared that improved instruction would be emphasized from the first through the twelfth year.

would again be followed this fall and that the funds in part or whole would go for purchasing teaching equipment.

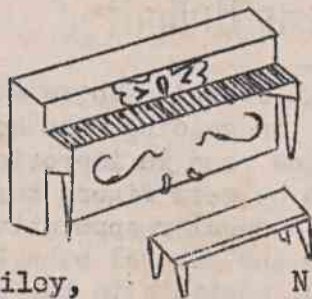
Regarding the attendance-record vote, the Organization voted to permit all parents and grandparents,

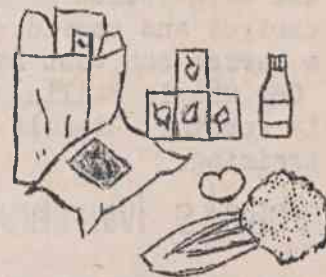
