The band now has twenty-four members in the senior band and nine in the junior band.

Total Enrollment Up At School Opening

Five hundred eighty-four students, more in total than in previous years, enrolled at Bailey High School, August 29, to begin new school term.

In grammar school the total number of students reaches 371, with the enrollment ranging from 29 to 41 in the different grades. These students are under the instruction of 11 elementary teachers.

The remaining 213 are high school students in

seven homerooms with nine high school teachers instructing them.

By adding the public school music teacher, the private music teacher, and the band leader to the other 20 members of the faculty, Bailey High has a total of 23 teachers.


