Menu

Each menu is checked by the State School Lunch Program to see if it contains all the necessary vitamins. For the month of October the government gave the lunchroom a quanity of canned roast pork, boil ham, pinto and lima beans, and cheese. The menus for the month were built around these surplus commodities. Milk is sold to any student for 3¢ a cup. During September, 12,020 cups were purchased by students and teachers.

Workers

Mrs. Everette Lamm and Mrs. E. O. Strickland assist Mrs. Lewis in the lunchroom. Twenty-three students also help each day. These people prepare and serve an average of 450 student plates daily and 17 adult plates.


