Expenses taken from the gross receipts of \$503.88 netted \$114.31.



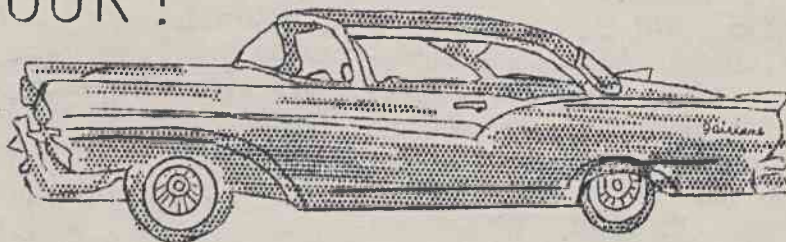
Interest in badminton has Mrs. Harvey Evans' eighth graders playing before school, at recess, during lunch time, and physical education period.
