Mrs. J. P. Underwood, present sixth grade teacher, taught Miss Bissette and Miss Farmer in grammar grade. Mrs. Howard Farmer, present French and English teacher, taught Miss Bissette French and English in high school. Miss Bissette took seven years of piano.


