L. Strickland Reigns As Miss Bailey


From the seven contestants competing in the Miss Bailey Christmas parade contest, representing the homerooms in high school, Lynda Anne Strickland received the honor.

8thGr.PresentsForce; Frosh Stage Play


Mrs. Harvey Evans eighth grade entertained the school with a farce play entitled "Henry, The Model Husband."


