truly believe her.

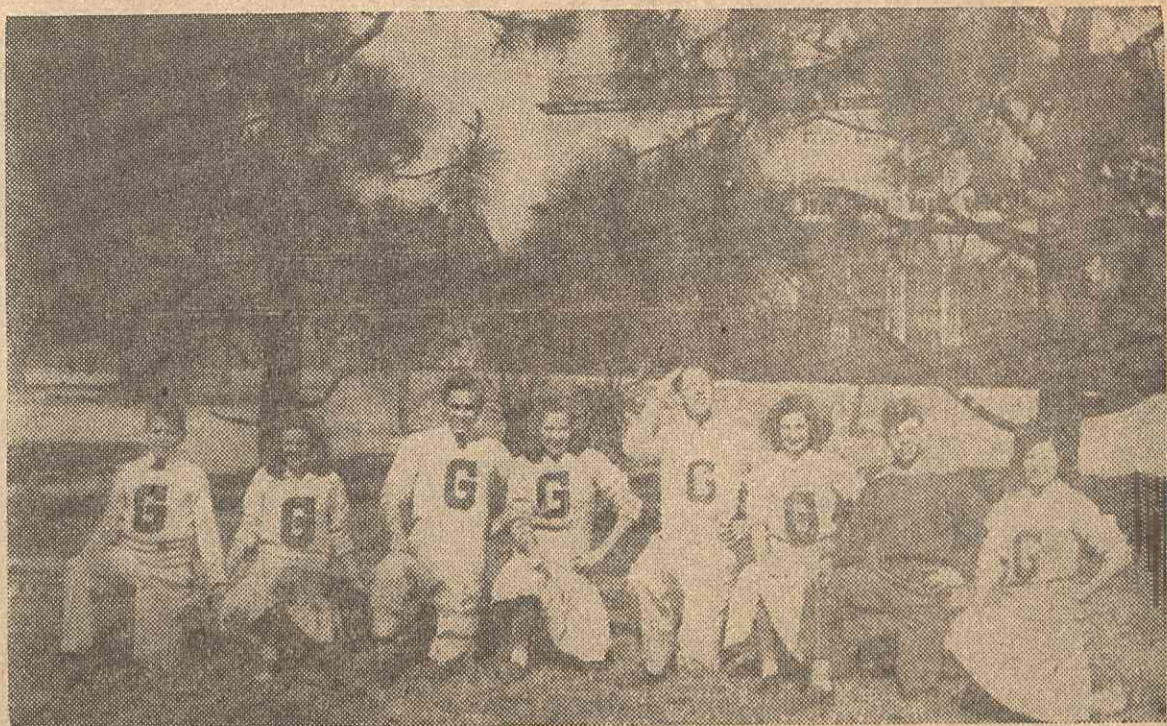
That blond who knows what she
