

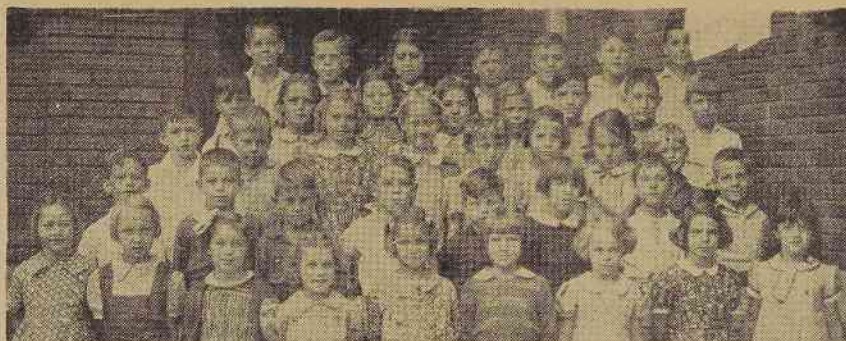
Evangelist Is Speaker For SA
