Most students do not relate the name of Mrs. Anne Williamson to those of Spanky, Alfalfa, Porky or Buckwheat. However, these names are remotely link-


"At the age of seven or eight, talent scouts came to Rocky Mount in search of children to act in "The Little Rascals" or "Our Gang" I don't remember which," she said.




