The club members learned that about three thousand copies of the Stanly News and Press are printed at one time—four pages, printed at one time—four as the paper winds off the spindle and four as it nears the cutter. Since the right page is necessary to keep the plates in register, the paper, equalizers are placed about the machine to take up the slack. The press itself is operated by one person, Miss Watson.
