College Money Being Made Available

The U.S. Army is easing the financial strain of a college education for America's high school seniors through the New G.I. Bill Plus the New Army College Fund.

Here are some facts high school seniors should know concerning the cost of continuing education:

- Tuition expenses for four years at a public college are estimated to be about \$24,000.

- Private college tuition can cost up to twice that of a public education.

- It's estimated that college costs increased 7-8 percent this fall compared to last year.

- The Army can offer \$25,200 for a four-year enlistment; \$22,800 for three-years, or \$17,000 for a two-year term.

The basic educational benefit through

the New G.I. Bill is \$10,800 for a three- or four-year Regular Army enlistment; \$9,000 for a two-year term. The personal contribution of \$1,200 is deducted from monthly pay at the rate of \$100 per month beginning with the first full month's pay. This contribution is the same regardless of the term of enlistment.

To participate in the New Army College Fund, a new soldier must have a high school diploma and score in the top half of the Army's aptitude test. The soldier must also enlist for one of approximately 85 critical skills needed by the Army.

These skills include training in law enforcement, foreign language, communications and maintenance. A full-range of combat arms specialties is also available.

The assistance from the New G.I. Bill

and the New Army College Fund must be used for continuing education at any of the approximately 6,200 approved colleges, universities and technical schools throughout the nation.

An Army Reserve enlistment offers a \$5,040 G.I. Bill education package.

Another education incentive is Tuition Assistance, a program that finances up to 75 percent of college tuition costs as the soldier attends school part-time while on active Army duty.
