

of these changes were:

(1) Setting the school machinery act up as a permanent piece of machinery for schools so that the whole act will not be up for adoption every two years.

(2) Provision for district supplementation in districts with 1,000 school population.

(3) A little greater protection for teachers in getting proper notice before they are to be relieved of their services.

(4) Clarification of the law at a number of points in the field of administration.
