**Dr. Tilley Travels With Seminar**

Perhaps some of you remember Sherwood Eddy, a slight, white-haired gentleman in his 80's who spoke in chapel last spring. Last summer Dr. Ethel Tilley, psychology professor at Meredith, toured England, France, Switzerland, Germany, Italy, and Yugoslavia with the Sherwood Eddy Seminar, composed of teachers, clergymen, lawyers, business men, and college presidents.

Back now at Meredith, Dr. Tilley recalls the trip with a great deal of pleasure. "Although much sightseeing was included in the tour, our primary objective was studying current European problems and conferring with top European officials about these problems. Wherever the Seminar traveled, it was welcomed by representatives of the state departments in every country. In England we were entertained by the Archbishop of Canterbury and Lady Aster, and met Chancellor of the Echequer Butler and Clement Atlee. In Germany we conferred with Burgermeister Reuter, of West Berlin, and in Yugoslavia we were received by Tito."

As part of the educational study, the Seminar was taken among other places to the Russian zone of Berlin, where they found the style of living much poorer, and the United Nations and the International Committee of Red Cross in Geneva, Switzerland. Everywhere in the western European countries they found that people wished, rather, to see United States tariff lowered so that they can find an-
