Dr. Thomas Grissom to speak

Dr. Thomas Grissom, black minister of Salem United Methodist Church in Harlem, will be Meredith's guest minister for Black Emphasis Week 1984. A dynamic speaker, Dr. Grissom draws a congregation of over 4000 people every Sunday.

Dr. Grissom has earned degrees from Clark College, Gammon Theological Seminary, and Interdenominational Theological Center. He earned a Doctor of Divinity degree from Houston-Tillotson College in Austin, Texas, and studied further at Columbia University and the University of

London.

Dr. Grissom is widely traveled and is a leader in civic and church activities nationally. He was a personal friend of Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr., and has been active in the black movement as well as in youth activities in the United States.

In recognition of Black Emphasis Week, Dr. Grissom will speak at a special worship service on February 15 at 10:00 A.M. in Jones Chapel. Everyone is invited to come hear this dynamic speaker and to meet him at a reception following the service.
