National Security Agency Test

The NSA Professional Qualifications Test is a prerequisite for applying for positions with the National Security Agency. All B.S.-B.A. degree candidates in the liberal arts, physical and natural sciences, business, and certain foreign languages may take this test. There is

NO TEST FEE. Deadline for applying for the October 28 test is October 11. A minimum of 3.0 GPA is required.

The NSA, located between Washington, DC and Baltimore, MD, is the national authority for all US communications security activities, develops foreign

intelligence information and is responsible for establishing Government computer security standards.


The Agency seeks graduates who possess a combination of ingenuity, intellectual curiosity, and perseverance. Imagination is the essential qualification.

The test is an aptitude test that mea-

sures an individual's ability to reason logically and to comprehend and manipulate a variety of verbal and quantitative materials. Occupational placement is made on the basis of demonstrated ability as well as Agency needs. Career Fields include: Computers, Language, Communications, Intelligence Research, and Management.
