Shackleford Banks had been authorized by Congress to be acquired and included as part of the Cape Lookout National Seashore so that its lonely beauty will be preserved for generations to come. Negotiations with the island's more than 50 private owners is now under way, and its final turnover to the National Park Service will probably occur in 1983.....

Winter is the perfect time to let the warmth of the sun enter your home in a play of light and color provided by stained glass - especially when the glass is a work of art you've designed yourself. For those interested in the techniques and how-to's of creative stained glass working, Johanna Aucremanne began a series of Thursday evening workshops February 12, 7-9 PM at the NC Marine Resources Center, Pine Knoll Shores. The class meets for four weeks, ending on March 5, and participants will have completed a project of their own design.
