

How would you react to a true emergency situation? If a loved one suddenly collapsed, could you recognize the signs of cardiac arrest (heart attack)? What should you do first?

HEART ATTACK

Call the emergency squad? Should you attempt to perform cardio-pulmonary resuscitation (CPR)? Would you know how to perform CPR?

WHAT TO DO?

The answers to these questions and much more vital information is taught by the Pine Knoll Shores Rescue Squad during its CPR classes. Qualified instructors -- certified by the American Heart Association -- are available to teach CPR to any groups of six, or more, persons. The four-hour classes will be taught at any location the participants wish, at the PKS Town Hall or at their home, office, motel or other meeting place, on any day of the week and at any hour they desire.

To start your CPR class: First, arrange with six or more family members, friends or neighbors; second, call Gil Millington (726-6819) or Joan Libby (247-2039), or PKS Town Hall (247-4353) to arrange the date, time and place.
