WHAT YOU CAN DO: Let your Legislators know that your state tax "check-off dollars" for the non-game and endangered species program should be used in part to fund the research of centers like OWLS. [OWLS receives no State funding, although over 2 million of your tax dollars have been received by the Wildlife Resources Commission.]
