New information has come to light on wells. Zoning Ordinance 21 has been amended by adding section 6.11 designating the location of wells and requiring a permit for well installation. This ordinance was passed September 14, it applies to new wells only regardless of depth or use (shallow, deep, irrigation, household or heat pump). Existing wells are grandfathered.
