FINANCE AND ADMINISTRATION

Budget Amendment VI, State Grant Sound Channel Dredging, in the amount of \$11,500 was passed unanimously as matching funds for a State Grant from the Dept. of Environment, Health and Natural Resources.

BUDGET MESSAGE

The proposed budget and message for FY 1995-96 was presented. A Public Hearing will be held prior to the regular Town Board meeting on June 13 at 2:00 p.m. A copy of the document is available for review by the public at Town Hall.

WASTE INDUSTRIES

An amendment to Waste Industries 3 year contract for FY 1995-96 was passed unanimously by the Board.

POLICE

BURNING ORDINANCE

Because of a conflict between the State Fire Code and the Town Ordinance on burning, the Commissioners voted to have the Planning Board review the Town Ordinance and bring it in line with the State Code.
