For the month of September, 1995, Pine Knoll Shores issued one residential permit valued at \$206,500 and 16 miscellaneous permits with a construction value of \$27,519.

REMINDER FROM FIRE & RESCUE CREWS


We are asked to remind residents of the following section from the Pine Knoll Shores Municipal Code "Every single family residential structure within the town shall post on the structure, or otherwise on the lot upon which such structure is located, a numerical street address assigned by the Town. The numerical street address must be readily visible from the nearest street right-of-way." Check to see that the number on your property is highly visible. This is especially important for fire and rescue response.
