## **Hurricane Bonnie Debris Removal**

**T**he Department of Transportation forwarded \$59,332.27 to Pine Knoll Shores from the 1998 Powell Bill Fund and the 1998 N.C. Highway Trust Fund. The Powell Bill Fund restricts use of the allocation to maintenance and construction of local streets and right-of—ways.
