Budget for FY 2000-2001

The proposed budget of \$2,046,114 for FY 2000-2001 was approved unanimously by the Board of Commissioners at the June 13 regular meeting.

Bulkheading of Canal Front Lots

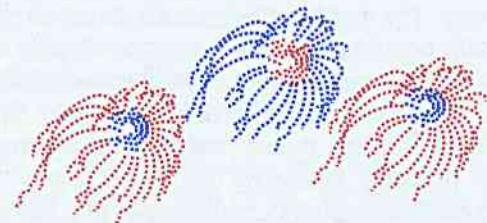
Because of soil and debris eroding into the canal from lots that are not bulkheaded, the Board of Commissioners on the recommendation of the Planning Board, adopted an ordinance requiring all canal front property to be bulkheaded. Owners whose lots are not bulkheaded will have three years from June, 2000 to have their lot bulkheaded. All bulkheads must be maintained in a good state of repair to prevent erosion of sand, soil and other debris into the canal.

Personnel
