\*\*Time to make sure you can locate your hurricane re-entry permit. If a permanent re-entry permit was previously issued a replacement will cost \$20. Re-entry permits can be obtained at Town Hall, but don't wait until the last minute. No permits will be issued once the evacuation order is given. Proof of residence is required.\*\*

\*\*YARD WASTE REMINDER\*\* 1) Waste Industries picks up and removes yard waste (yard waste consisting solely of vegetative matter resulting from landscape maintenance) from the single family residences and approved multifamily projects in the Town. Such items shall include limbs, debris, leaves, straw, clipped shrubbery, bushes, grass and weed trimmings. Leaves, debris, straw, clippings or trimmings must be bagged, boxed or containerized. Limbs, shrubbery or other long items must be securely tied in bundles no longer than four (4) feet in length and no larger than eighteen (18) inches in diameter. Each
