



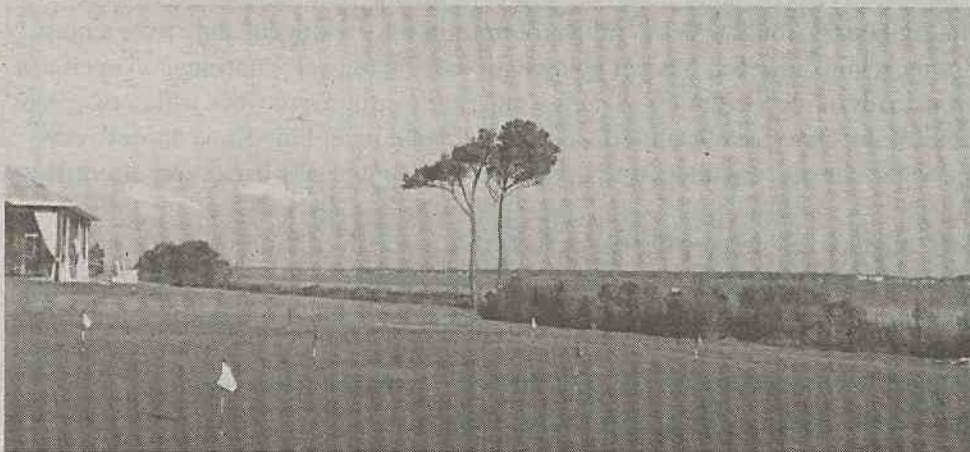
## Senior Tapping Talents

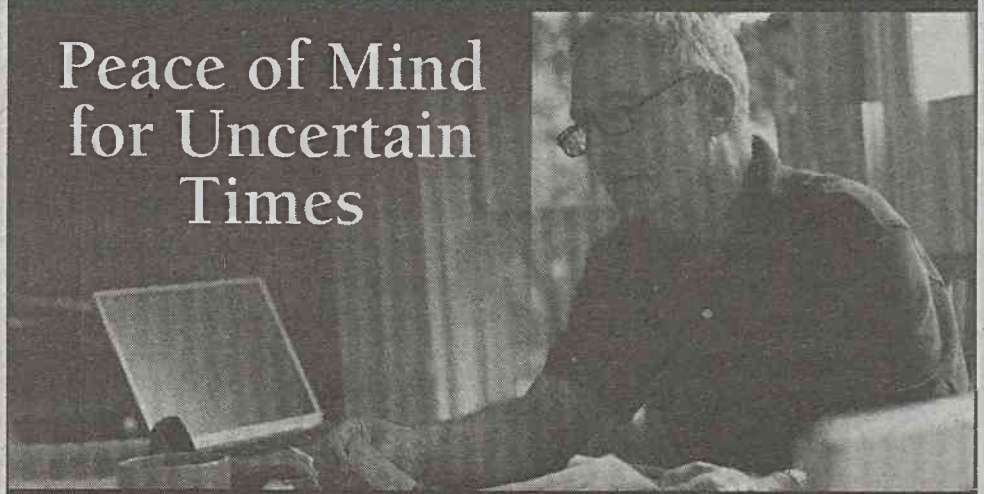
## Country Club News
