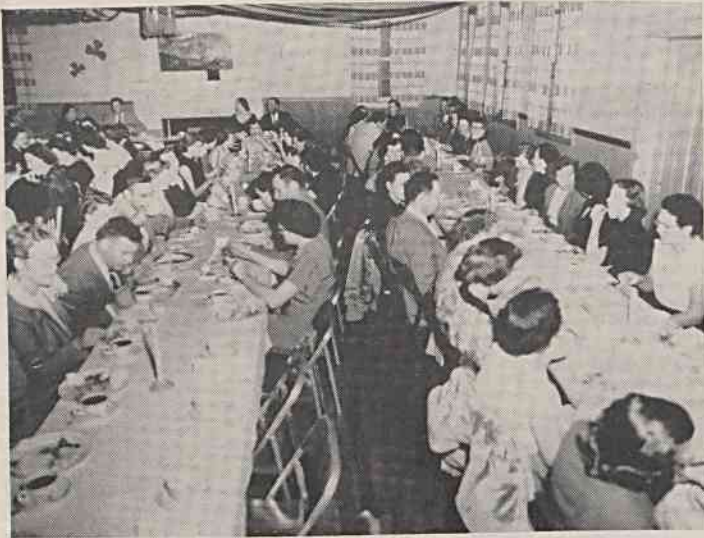


Junior Council Social Is Enjoyable Affair
