

## Sales Secretary Wins Prize At Boston Show



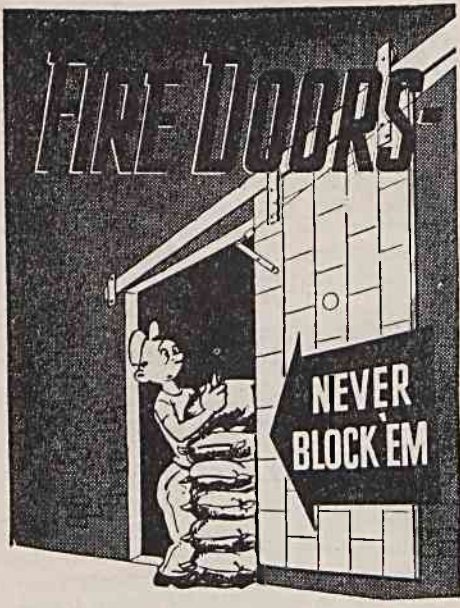
Fieldcrest was prominent in the recent "Adventures in Good Living Show" held at Symphony Hall in Boston, Mass.

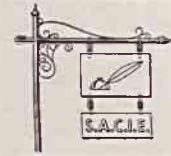
