helping to preserve the roof deck and the inside floors.

The old saw-tooth type roof tended to "sweat" extensively. The glass windows permitted heat to escape in winter and heat from outside to infiltrate in summer, making it difficult to maintain uniform conditions in the weave room.

In 1957 Fieldcrest lowered the roof over the Carding Department at the Bedsread Mill. The roof was flattened at the Sheeting Mill in 1958 as part of the extensive modernization program

at that mill. The roof over the Blanket Weave Room was flattened in 1959 and the Towel Mill Room roof in 1960.

Members of our Engineering Department say that all over the South mills are getting rid of the old saw-tooth roofs and that practically no new textile mills are being built with the saw-tooth construction.

The safety scoreboard for August follows below:

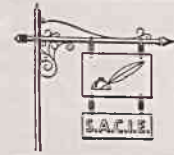
