## Edith V. Aaron Retires; Was Inspector 35 Years

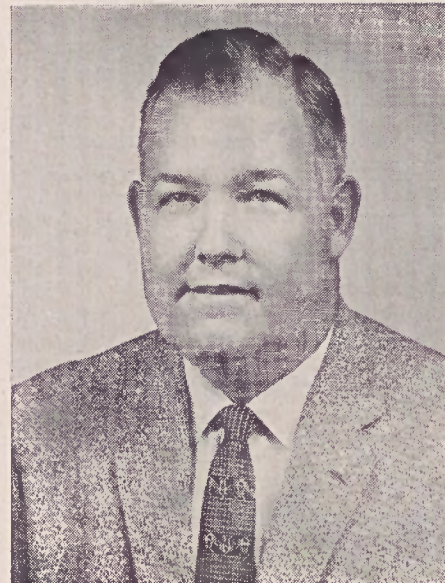
