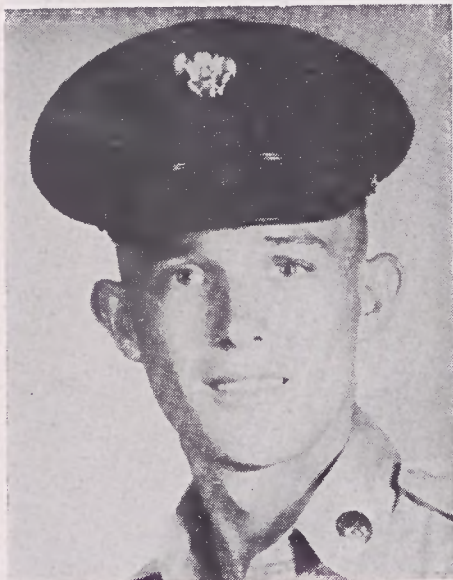


## Home On Leave

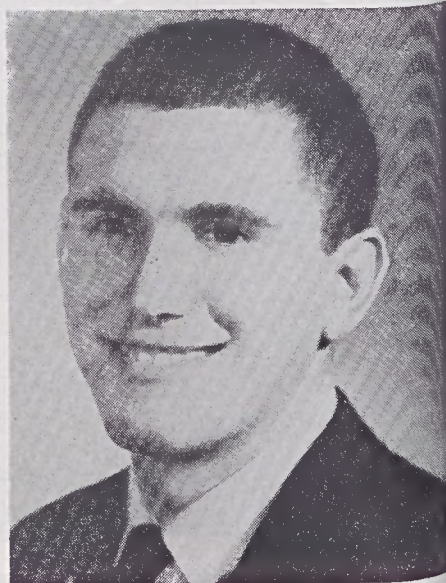

## Carroll Is Transferred To Nye-Wait Rug Mill

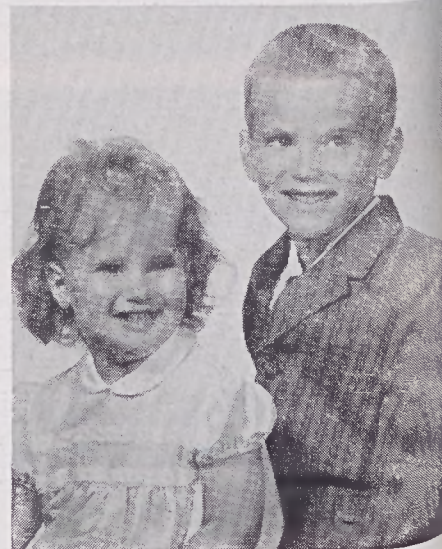
