McBride Twins



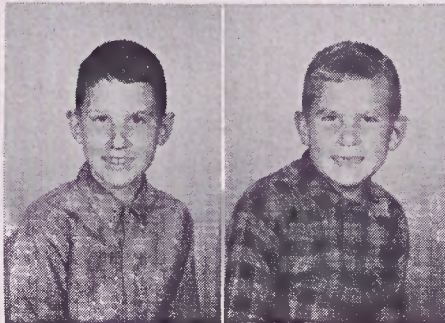
Todd O'Neal and Tina Leigh McBride are the children of Mr. and Mrs. Tommie McBride. The twins are four years old today, April 14.
