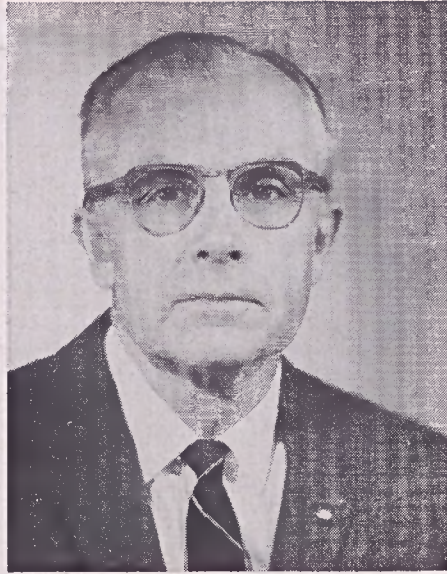

Curry And Mason Receive Service Awards

Allen Curry of the Bedsread Mill today, May 12, completes a record of 45 years of continuous service.

Also reaching an outstanding milestone of service during May was James Arnie Mason, who completed 40 years of unbroken service on May 6.

Mr. Curry, a native of Henry County, Va., was first employed as a doffer in the old Nantucket Spinning Department May 12, 1924. He was transferred to the Draper Sheeting Mill as a section hand when sheeting operations were consolidated there in 1937. He later worked on various jobs at the Sheeting,

Woolen and Blanket Mills and has been a quill collector and cleaner at the Bedsread Mill since 1955.

Mr. Mason, also a Henry County native, was first employed in the old Jack Spinning Department at the Blanket Mill in 1919, although his service was not continuous since that time. He worked as a doffer during the early 1920's and became a spinner and doffer May 6, 1929. He has continuous service since the latter date. Mr. Mason became a Model E spinner in 1949 and continues to work in that classification at the present time.
