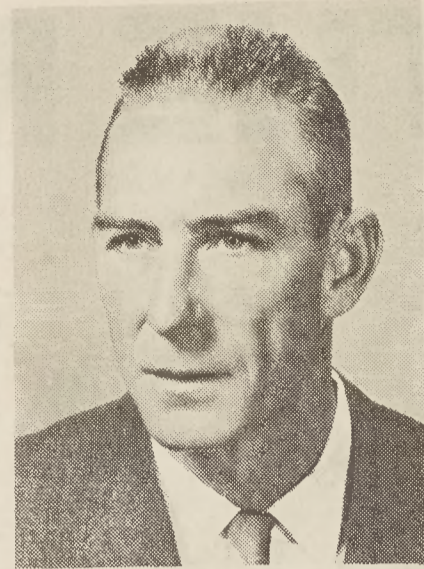
Each long service employee has received the Fieldcrest 45-year service emblem, a \$45 gift certificate for company merchandise, and a letter of commendation from president William C. Battle.

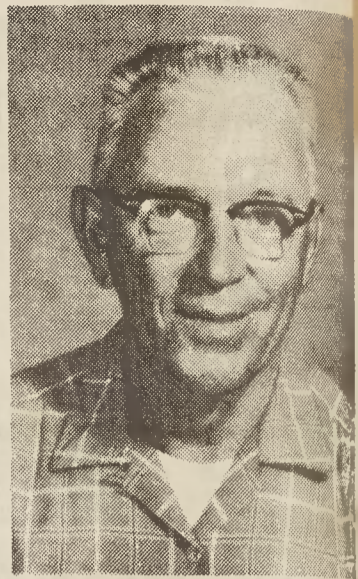
William J. Robertson,
