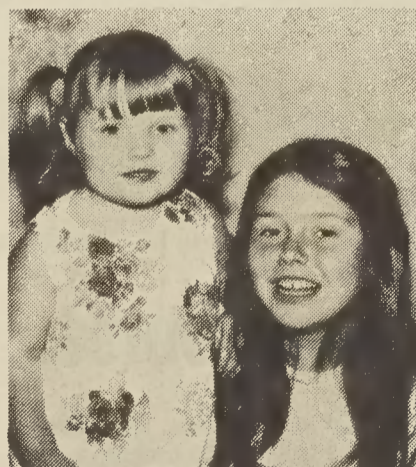


Honored At Baby Shower

Fire Prevention Week Oct. 6-12

National Fire Prevention Week is being observed this week, October 6 through October 12, and all Fieldcrest employees are being asked to cooperate in making the program as successful as possible.

The program in Fieldcrest plants will include reports by mill inspection committees with particular attention to fire hazards; reviews of the overall plans of exterior cleaning and collection of waste, etc.; a special clean-up day; and practice fire alarms for the fire brigades.

Also included will be discussions and demonstrations on the use of fire extinguishers by fire brigade members and a complete clean-up of each mill premises.

In Eden area plants, a special fire extinguishing program has been set up which will be conducted by the Eden Fire Chief along with a fire protective equipment sales engineer.
