




Weave Room in 1966 and is complete with a modern underfloor air return system in all departments except Carding.

Since Fieldcrest Mills, Inc. purchased the mills in 1953, the machinery at the Draper Sheeting Mill has been completely revamped. A number of new looms were installed, including some of the most modern available. The remaining approximately two-thirds of the looms and the mill's cards were upgraded and modernized. In recent years outstanding advances were made in modernization of the yarn manufacturing equipment.


