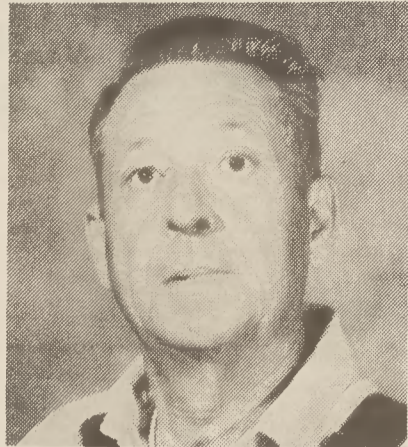

# Six Complete Long Records Of Service



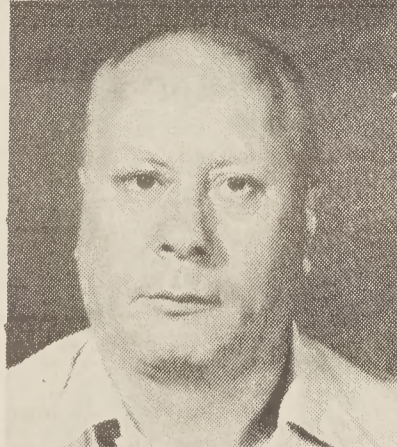

Mr. Nester began continuous service on March 3, 1930, as a



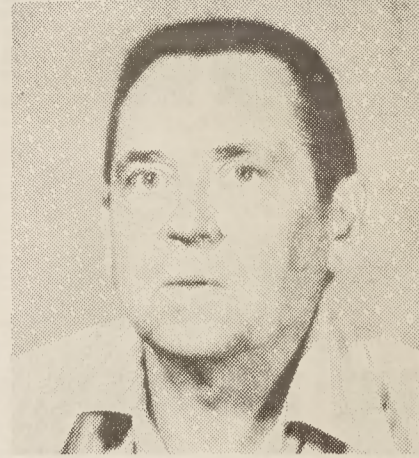

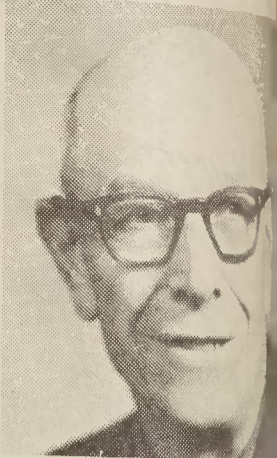

his 40 years. He has worked as a cloth hauler, weaver, overhauler and loom fixer, his present classification.

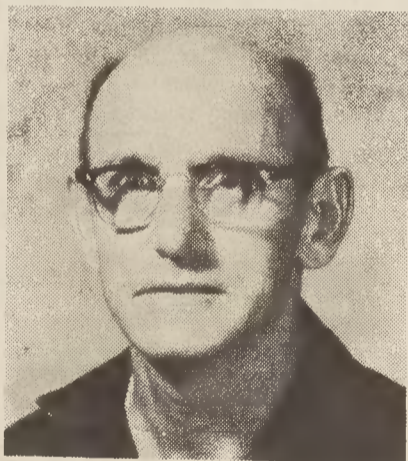
