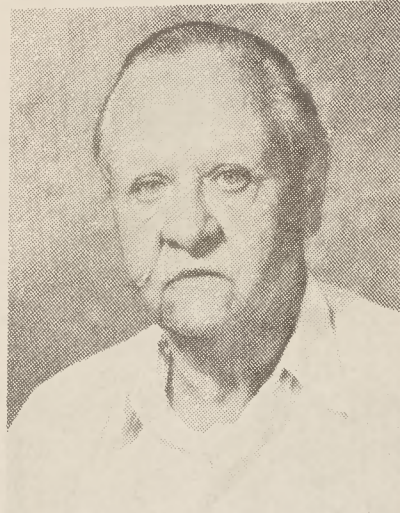
Complete Outstanding Service Records

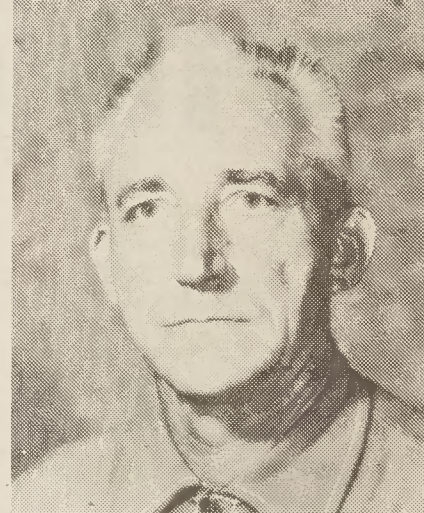
