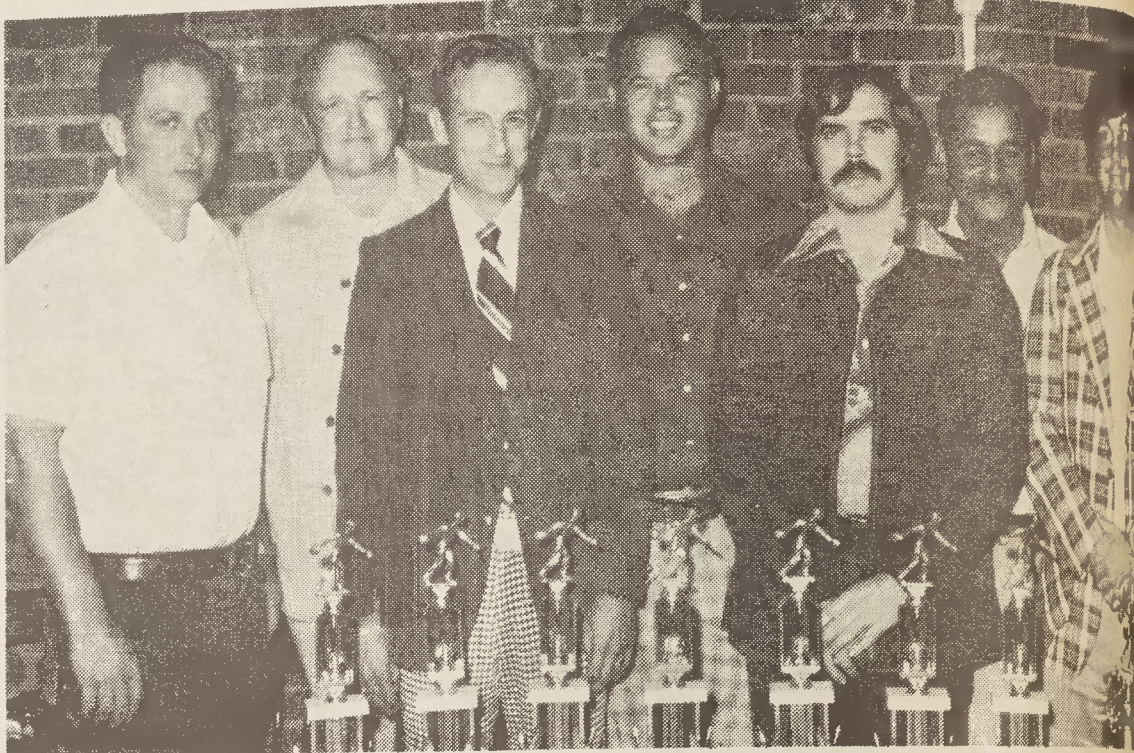


Laurelcrest Bowlers Receive Annual Awards

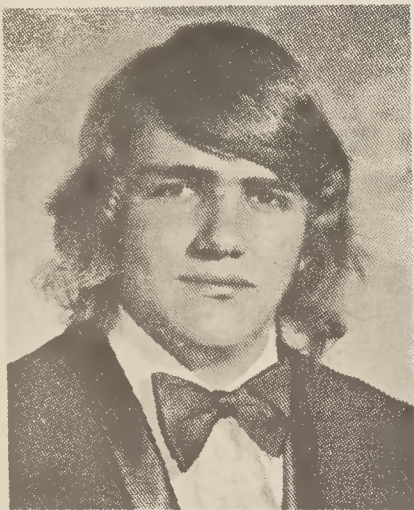

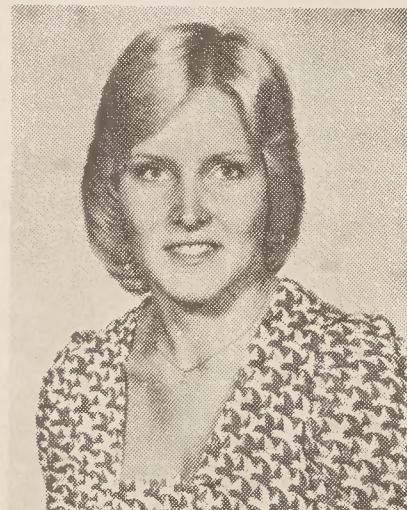

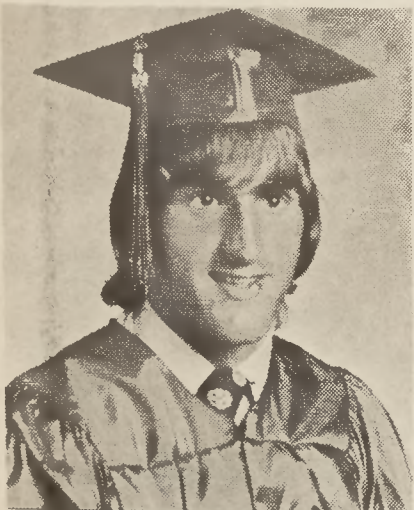

North Rowan Senior High School. Daughter of Mr. and Mrs. Jim Beck. Both parents are employed in the Finishing Department at North Carolina Finishing.



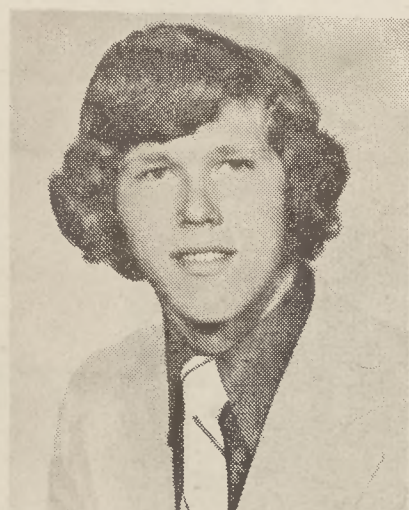
BETSY BARBER

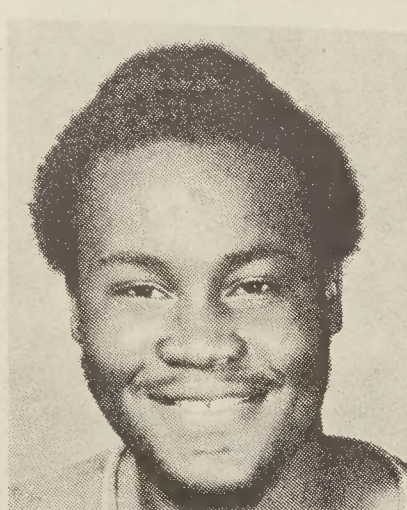
