Gets Awards

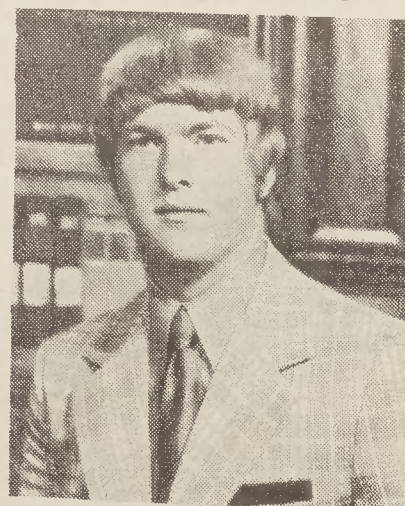
