

# Safety Barbecues Held At Two Locations

## Whiteville Plant

Employees at the Whiteville plant enjoyed a safety barbecue on April 8 after having attained an average of 2,141 hours per employee without a lost-time injury, and a total of 118,651 hours for the plant. The last time injury was in the month of 1974.
