They are Ron Noble, treasurer, Frank Jordan, director of communications, and Donald Gwarek, director of publicity.

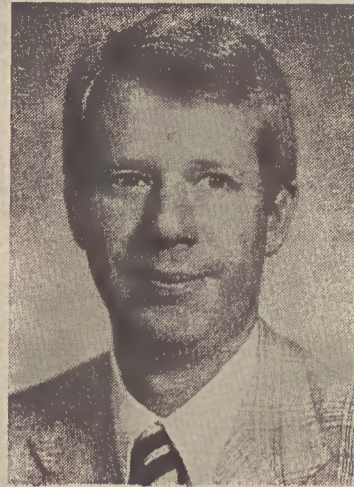
