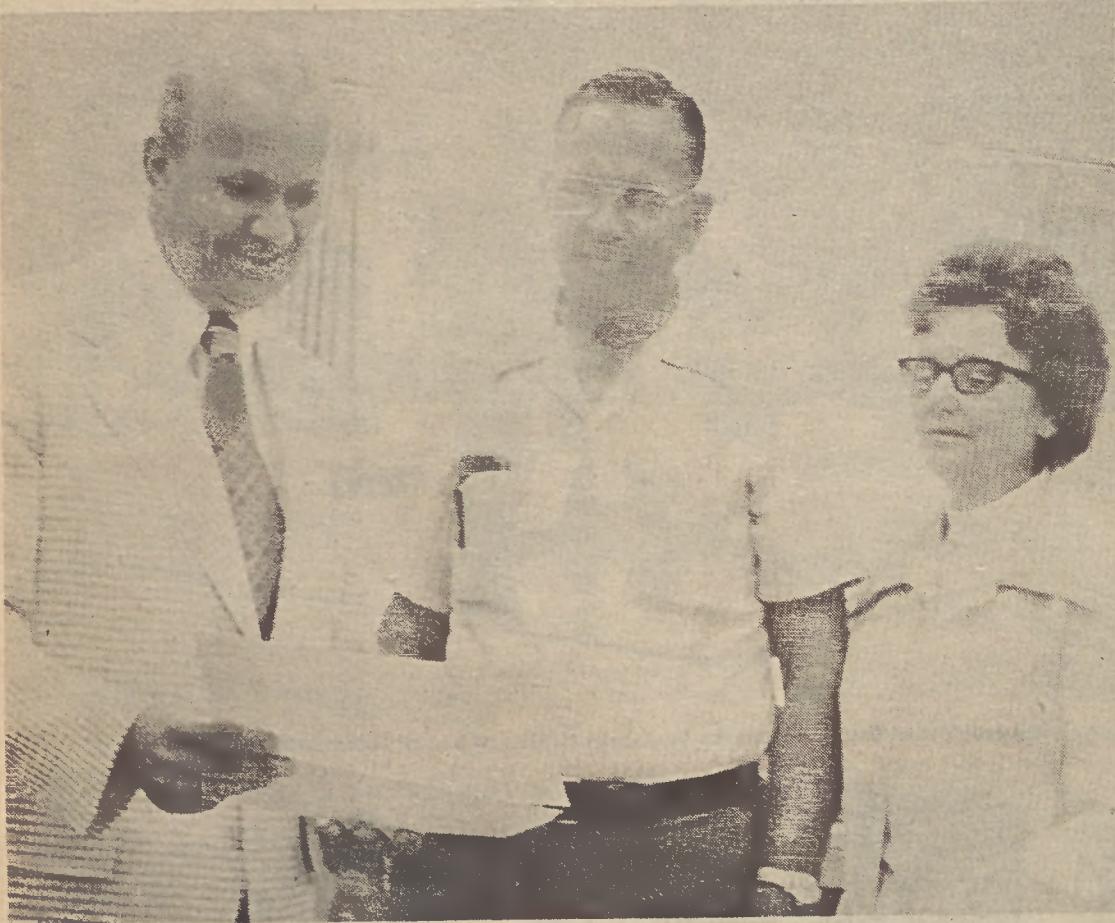

Youth Is Honored For Outstanding Athletics

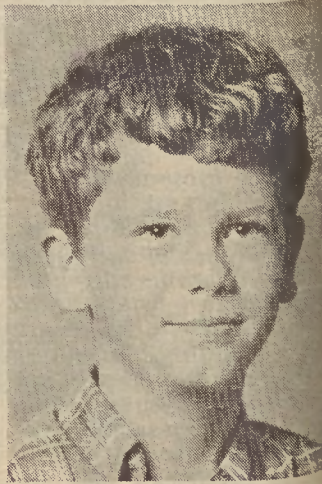
Richard Wright, son of Mr. and Mrs. Grady Wright of Columbus, was chosen as a Babe Ruth Athlete of the Year for 1976.

Richard's father is a super-



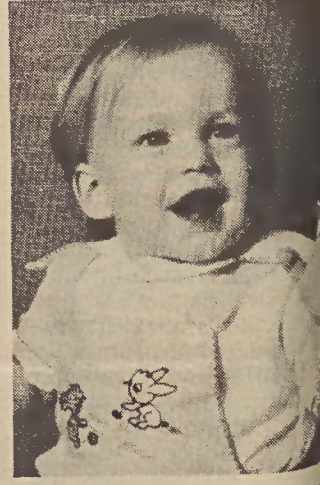

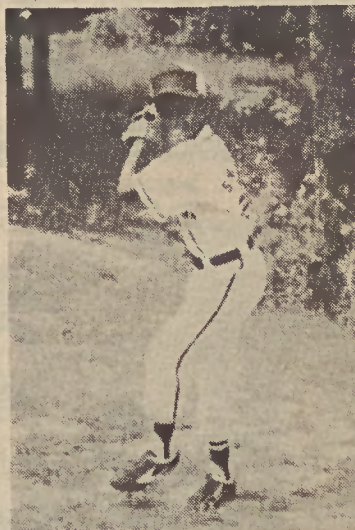
