### July 1 Is Grant Application Deadline

Applications for educational ants-in-aid from the Fieldcrest and ation must be received by 1 to be considered for the fall mester

Applications for grants should be mitted to the office of M. B. tanklin, General Offices den, N. C. 27288. Application forms be obtained from the area managers.

the qualifications for educational ants-in-aid are:

Applications are taken only once year, during June with a diline of July 1.

The employee (parent) must one year of continuous service the company as of the date of plication.

3. The applicant normally is planning to attend college for less than a four-year program, but four-year programs are eligible.

4. Applicant can have prior college experience or may be enrolled at present.

5. Grants are primarily awarded on the basis of financial need along with consideration of scholastic aptitude for college work.

6. Child possibly may not be eligible if married or has established own residence or livelihood.

The grants-in-aid should not be confused with the Fieldcrest Scholarships awarded each year for a four-year college program only and are not available to students who have completed some college work.

#### **Employees To Get Benefits Statements**
