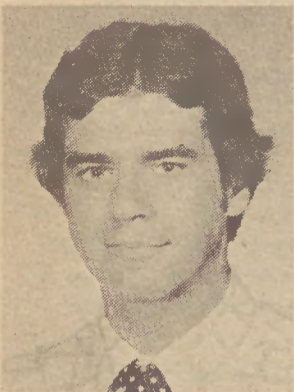

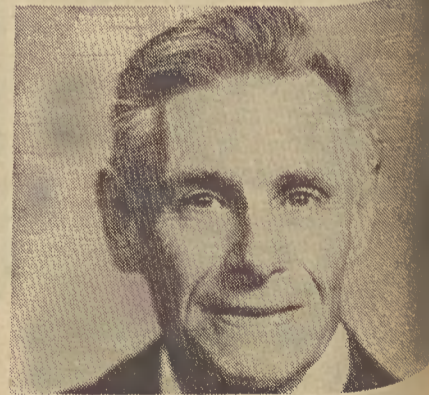
Collins, who has been active in the organization for the past six years, has also served as assistant secretary, secretary and as a member of various committees. He has been with Fieldcrest since 1969.
