35-Year-Old Bath Set Still In Good Shape!

Most Fieldcrest employees will agree that the company markets long lasting, high quality products. But one former employee has actual proof this statement is true.

Roy Meadows, a native of Eden who now lives in Hazelwood, Missouri, returned to his hometown recently for his 30th high school class reunion. Thinking ahead about the nostaigic trip he was to make, Meadows decided to include a side visit to the company he once worked for with a surprise package — a 35-year-old bath set.

Meadows received the bath set, including two towels, two washcloths and a bath mat, as a gift from Fieldcrest when he was top student in the Carding and Spinning vocational class as a tenth-grader at Leaksville High School in 1945.

"My mother put the set away for me and I didn't think any more about it until I returned home from the service in 1958 and she got it out for me," he said. "It's been in constant use since then and I thought someone in quality control at Fieldcrest might be interested in it because it's still in pretty good condition. The washcloths did wear out about two years ago, though."

Employees at Fieldale report the bath set was one of the Morning Glory line made by Fieldcrest for Marshall Field and Company in 1941. Meadows worked for Fieldcrest as a teenager. His sister, Odessa Meadows Taylor, now works in the Burling Department at the Karastan Rug Mill and her husband, Maynard, is a fixer at Karastan.
