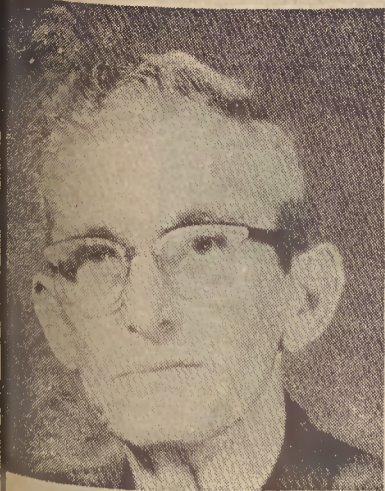

Albert B. Sumner, project machinist, Karastan Rug Mill, four years.



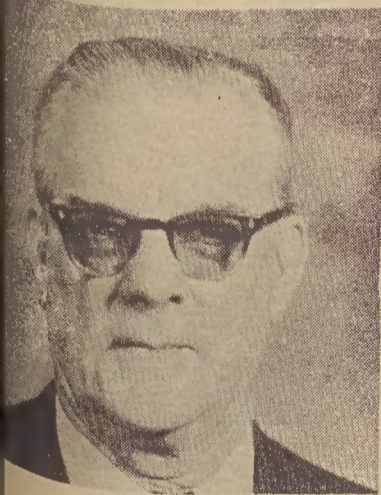

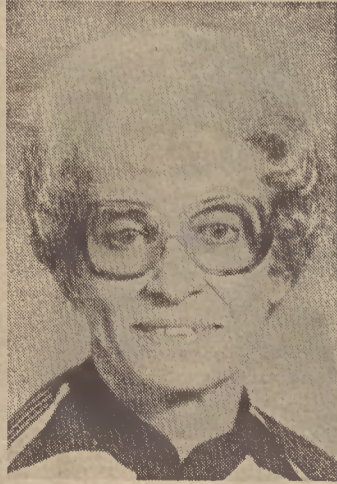
